

I am priceless

I am priceless. Sex is priceless. Through the buying of sex, also known as prostitution, the dignity of the prostitute and the client is taken away. The buying of sexual services should therefore be penalized. I request the Second Chamber to discuss this proposition and to take a stand on it.



1. I SIGN FOR EQUALITY

Prostitution takes away equality of humans, as is described in Article 1 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. The dignity of the human body is taken away because it is sold and bought; the person is treated as merchandise.

2. I SIGN FOR FREEDOM

Prostitution takes away the freedom of humans (a breach of Article 3 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights), because people in a vulnerable position are exploited. The freedom of some prostitutes in the Netherlands is constrained to such an extent that it resembles slavery (a breach of Article 4 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights); they are victims of trafficking.



3. I SIGN FOR A NEW POLICY

The legalization of prostitution in the Netherlands has not led to less misconducts in the sector. It is time for a new policy.
